Fresh Start provides a wide range of comprehensive services customized for each woman's unique needs. Of the over 4,200 unique women served in the last fiscal year:

- 67% are domestic violence survivors
- 62% are single mothers
- 29% are experiencing homelessness or housing insecurity
- 59% make a household income under 25k
- 100% took steps to better their life and achieve sufficiency
