THE NEED IN ARIZONA

Without education or job training, women's career prospects and earning potential are greatly limited. As a result, they often land in low-wage roles that do not provide enough income. Many struggle to provide for themselves and their children, and the risky cycle of living paycheck to paycheck persists. In Arizona, nearly 6 in 10 minimum wage workers are women¹, and over 480,000 women are below the poverty line².

Working one-or several-minimum wage jobs is not a sustainable solution in an economy with rising living costs and an increasingly competitive job market. The key to disrupting cycles of generational poverty and earning higher wages is access to education and career training opportunities.

professionally empower women.


